Re: Parking at Harvard for 2011 Summer Games

Dear SOMA Participant / Supporter:

We would like to inform you of where to park at Harvard University when attending Summer Games, June 18/19. If you are not staying over at BU and must take your vehicle to Harvard, please help SOMA and the Harvard parking staff by using the following options when attending the 2011 games.

1) Use SOMA Transportation from Boston University

Park at BU's Babcock lots and Warren Tower garage. Parking is free!! SOMA shuttles will pick you up at the concrete steps on Babcock St (between Sleeper and Rich Halls) and at the corner of Cummington and Comm Ave.

2) Soldiers Field Rd Parking Garage on Western Ave (see map below)

For those who must have a car at Harvard and choose not to take SOMA transportation from BU, park in the Soldiers Field Rd Garage on Western Ave. Follow the Parking signs. Parking is \$5 per car per day. Shuttles will be running all day to take you to and from Gate 6 entrance. Garage will be open from 6am –5pm both Saturday and Sunday. You must remove your car by 5pm or it will be locked in the garage overnight.

3) Use Public Transportation

The Red line stops in Harvard square and it is a 10-minute walk to the Athletic Complex. The #66 and #86 bus stop at Harvard Stadium and Gate 6. For schedules and transit info visit www.mbt.com
