Essex/Suffolk County: Barnes & Noble, North Shore Mall (210 Andover Street, Peabody)

Hampden/Hampshire County: Basketball Hall of Fame near Max's/Plan B (1000 Hall of Fame Ave., Springfield)

Middlesex County: Sears parking lot, Burlington Mall (1100 Middlesex Turnpike, Burlington)

Norfolk County: ***Arrive 9:15AM for 9:30AM Convoy*** Lot 3B by Showcase Cinemas, Patriot Place (24 Patriot Place, Foxborough)

Plymouth County: Front parking lot, Plymouth North High School (41 Obery Street, Plymouth)

Worcester County: Wyman Gordon (244 Worcester Street, North Grafton)

Worcester County (2nd location): Leominster, **TBD Information**

The Cruiser Convoy will look different this year. It will be a parade or procession of official law enforcement and public safety vehicles in and out of the public rally location at 10:00AM (*unless otherwise stated above). Officers will not get out of their cars to greet athletes, but will wave from inside their cruisers as they pass by. The parade is expected to last no more than 15 minutes, and everyone viewing the parade is expected to leave that location as soon as the last cruiser in the parade leaves.

To ensure the health and safety of everyone involved, and in accordance with state and local guidance, we recommend that all people viewing a Cruiser Convoy parade on Saturday, June 13th adhere to safe social distancing guidelines and take the follow precautions:

- Stay in your cars
- Do not carpool with individuals outside of your household
- Wear masks
- Show up to your Cruiser Convoy parade location between 9:45AM-9:55AM (*unless otherwise stated above) and leave that location as soon as the last cruiser leaves.
